Scholarship Qualifications

Candidates must:

- Be a male high school senior who is enrolled full time and attends a public high school in Richland One, Richland Two, Lexington One, Lexington Two, Lexington Three, Lexington Four, Lexington/Richland Five, or Fairfield County Schools
- Be a graduate during the 2023-2024 academic school year and will enroll in a two-or four-year accredited institution of higher learning
- Demonstrate character that aligns with and represents the Fraternity's Four Cardinal Principles of Manhood, Scholarship, Perseverance, and Uplift

Scholarship Scoring Rubric

Essay – 100 Points

Theme: School Dropout data indicates that African American Males dropout of school at an alarming high rate: Explain what you believe can be done to reduce the number of African American Males from dropping out of high school.

500 Words – APA Format to include a title page, running header, and work cited page

- Development of Topic/Thesis Statement Topic is well developed and covers major points, supplying enough information for understanding (30 possible points)
- Progression Composition progresses from beginning to end in a logical flow of information (20 possible points)
- Readability Concise prose that sticks to the point and does not ramble; holds reader's attention (25 possible points)
- Grammar Subject and verb agreement, proper tense, correct sentence structure, paragraphing including transitional phrases (15 possible points)
- Spelling (5 possible points)
- Punctuation (5 possible points)

Community - Leadership - Character (100 points)

- Resume
 - o Awards, Honors, and Accomplishments (25 points)
 - Community Service Hours (must be documented) (40 points)
 - Demonstrated Leadership (25 points)
- Three (3) Letters of Reference from (7 points)
 - A Member of Omega Psi Phi (3 points)
 - A Community Member (2 points)
 - A Teacher/Administrator/Counselor (2 points)
- Alumni of 6th District Boys Camp (3 points)

Grade Point Average and Transcript

- Based on current Cumulative Average
- Copy of High School Transcript with Principal or Principal Designee's Signature

Legacy (20 bonus points)

- Father or Grandfather member of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity
 - Chapter Name and Year of Initiation
 - Control #
 - Member must be in good financial standing at the local, district, and international level
